Do you want to experience the Spanish language and culture at first hand before you go to college? Would you like to stay with a friendly local Spanish family and improve your Spanish at a local school?

Euroace enables you to continue your studies at a public high school in the Valencian region (on the Mediterranean coast) and attend courses with Spanish natives.



About the Program:

Choose the duration

The great thing is, you get to choose the period of time you want to complete your studies with us; you can stay for one month up to an entire academic year, depending on your requirements!

A complete language immersion

All courses at the high school are delivered in the Spanish language. Any extracurricular activities will also be in Spanish!

A complete cultural immersion

As part of the program, you'll get to live with a local Spanish family located in the same town as the high school you attend. This will help you to learn all about the local culture as well as practice your speaking skills. You'll be able to meet new people, take part in typical customs and celebrations, and completely immerse yourself in the Spanish language and culture!

Extracurricular Activities:

Students can participate in extracurricular activities just like they would at home. Get involved in sports, music, theatre, etc. Sports and music are not part of the school system so these would be done entirely outside of school hours and are completely optional.

Requirements

- Basic Spanish knowledge (highly recommended)
- Students must be at least 12 years old to enroll

Transfer of Credits

The possibility to transfer credits back home will depend entirely on the student's local high school regulations and whether or not they will accept the high school credits from the Spanish school. Usually this will depend on the Ministry of Education, and it will need to be processed through the Spanish Embassy in the student's home country. Euroace will provide any documents necessary to prove the collaboration with the high school, but we cannot guarantee that the credits are transferable.

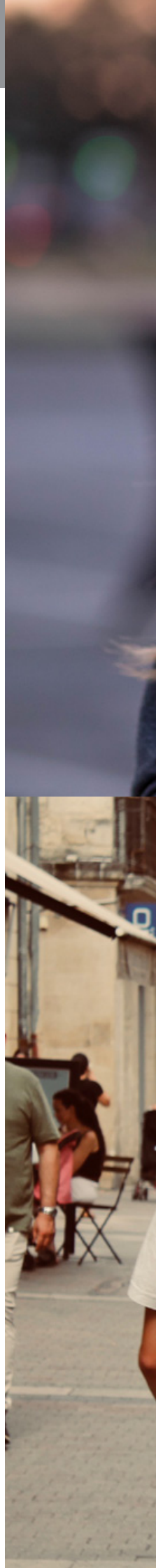

About the Spanish School System:

The high-quality Spanish school system provides us with the possibility for this unique collaboration where students can be fully immersed in the local culture. Secondary school in Spain begins when students are 12 or 13 years old and lasts for 4 years, followed by 2 more years of Bachillerato which would be the equivalent of 11th and 12th grade in the USA or College / Sixth form age in the UK.

Students who choose to complete an academic year in Spain are typically in their last two years of secondary school (14-16 years old) or in their first year of Bachillerato (16/17 years old). The school always decides which year they feel is most adequate based on the student's previous studies.







FAQs:

Do I need to be able to speak Spanish before attending an academic year in Spain?

We recommend a Spanish level of A2 if possible. If students have a level below A2, we would suggest coming to Valencia early and taking an intensive Spanish course for at least one month so they feel more comfortable when starting school. It's also possible to continue with private and /or group Spanish classes with Euroace throughout the academic year for however long the student feels necessary.

Will I be bilingual after I finish the semester or academic year?

This is generally the case for a semester and especially if the students are here for an entire academic year. However, this varies from student to student based on their own previous knowledge and how much they apply themselves throughout the program.

Do I live with other kids my own age?

In general yes, most families who accept students have children between the ages of 12 - 17.

Is it possible to come at other times of the year for a shorter stay?

Yes, students can come for 2-3 months if they prefer; usually the minimum stay for this exchange would be one month.

How far are the schools from Valencia?

Students live in small towns outside of Valencia which are communicable to Valencia by a short train ride or by car. They go to a high school within the town.

How do I get started?

Contact us and let us know the following information to get started: the students' date of birth and which courses they have completed thus far.

Are there any cultural activities included in the program?

Usually students are able to do cultural activities with their families, especially when here for the entire academic year. There are also some cultural activities held by Euroace which students can participate in depending on the time of year and the age limits for the activities.
