

Spanish Course Syllabus (Level 0/A1) – 60 Hours Over Two Weeks

Day 1:

- Lesson 1 (2 hours): Greeting and goodbyes, personal introductions with the verb “to be”, in the present tense. Nationalities, use of gender, numbers, use of singular and plural.
- Lesson 2 (2 hours): Alphabet, practice of sounds, /K/ /Z/ /Ñ/ /RR/, job vocabulary, games to practice the spelling of Spanish names .
- Lesson 3 (2 hours): The verb “to be” in present tense, days of the weeks, months of the year, seasons and colours. Interrogative pronouns.

Day 2:

- Lesson 4 (2 hours): Verb “to have”, “to be” in the present tense. Interrogative pronouns “what?” and “how many?” revision of nationalities, countries, numbers 0 - 80.
- Lesson 5 (2 hours): Verb “to cost” in present tense with pronoun “cuanto?”. Numbers up to 100. Vocabulary: clothing and colours.
- Lesson 6 (2 hours): Verb “there is/there are”, Vocabulary; parts of house, and Kitchen appliances.

Day 3:

- Lesson 7 (2 hours): Verb “to be/ to have” with physical adjectives. Vocabulary; parts of the body, hair and eyes, colours and lengths.
- Lesson 8 (2 hours): Verb “estar” to express location in the present tense, adverbs and prepositions of place.
- Lesson 9 (2 hours): Verb “to be/ to have” with possessive pronouns (my, your, his/her) and the family. Revision of numbers. Physical description of members of the family, age, profession. Make and describe your family tree.

Day 4:

- Lesson 10 (2 hours): Present indicative tense. Regular verbs the end -AR (to cook, to work, to study). Expressions using time; everyday, weekly, never, always, often, etc.
- Lesson 11 (2 hours): Restaurants and bars/ foods and drinks. Mains dishes, starters and local dishes. Verb “to order” (pedir) in present indicative tense. Communicative role play in a restaurant.
- Lesson 12 (2 hours): Weather. Verbs to be/ there is/ to do

Day 5:

- Lesson 13 (2 hours): to be/ there is/are - the city. ‘What is in your city?’, ‘Where is/Where are?’
- Lesson 14 (2 hours): Verb ‘to like’, outdoor activities and related vocabulary.
- Lesson 15 (2 hours): Revision of verbs in the present indicative tense, days of the week, seasons of the year, months of the year, numbers, physical and non physical descriptions

Day 6:

- Lesson 16 (2 hours): How to ask for the time and how to tell the time. Revision of verbs related to daily routine, to get up, to eat breakfast, to have lunch, to eat, to cook, to shower, to work, to eat dinner.
- Lesson 17 (2 hours): To go grocery shopping/ to go shopping. Types of shops; bakery, fishmongers, butchers, florist, fruit shop, Verb "to go" in present indicative.
- Lesson 18 (2 hours): Irregular verbs in the present indicative tense. Radical changing verbs e.g. (cerrar; e- ie = cierra). Verbs; to want; to understand; to water.

Day 7:

- Lesson 19 (2 hours): Verb "to go", and modes of transport, prepositions, in/ at. Small and big trips. Travel vocabulary; suitcase, dryer, shoes, flipflops.
- Lesson 20 (2 hours): Verb to like, to love, and to be interested.
- Lesson 21 (2 hours): Very/ much and their plural forms. Verbs to know (conocer) to express questions such as; How many countries do you know? Do you know the local dishes in Spain? How many people do you know in Spain?

Day 8:

- Lesson 22 (2 hours): Comparison to superiority, inferiority and equality. Compare Spain with other countries' food, drinks, traditions, cities, and weather. Comparative adjectives; big/ small/ pretty/ ugly/ fun/ tall/ small/ thin/ fat
- Lesson 23 (2 hours): Irregular verbs in the present indicative tense. Radical changing verbs o - ue. To usually, to cost, to be able to, to have lunch, to sleep. Weekly routine.
- Lesson 24 (2 hours): Types of houses; apartment, flat, chalet, farmhouse, villa. Describe your ideal house. Adjectives to describe your house.

Day 9:

- Lesson 25 (2 hours): Contrast verbs (SER/ESTAR) "To be". Express qualities or characteristics (character, size, color, material, appearances). Express nationalities, professions, descriptions and evaluations. Express places, conditional tense and variables, state of health and mood. Birthplace, and date of birth, characteristics of place and location.
- Lesson 26 (2 hours): Verb "to be" + "ing" in the present indicative. Domestic chores.
- Lesson 27 (2 hours): Direct object pronouns. Habitual verbs; to buy, to cook, to eat, to wear.

Day 10:

- Lesson 28 (2 hours): Verb “to wear/bring” (llevar) + clothes, colours, and shapes. Events in which we wear specific clothing; a wedding, a funeral, a party, a concert, a job interview.
- Lesson 29 (2 hours): Irregular verbs in the present indicative tense, Radical changing verbs (e-i, ex. pedir - pido). Shopping on Amazon, ordering food to takeaway, ordering in a restaurant or cafe.
- Lesson 30 (2 hours): Present perfect of Indicative. (ex. to have eaten). Trips.
